EDUCATION POLICY

Introduction

In keeping with the Association's position as a Not-for-Profit educational institution in accordance with federal regulations 501-3 (C), it is paramount that the museum maintain a reputable education program.

Policy

It is the policy of the Association that priority be given to the "Education Mission" of the museum, recognizing that its Non-Profit status is derived therefrom.

Education Mission as used in this policy is construed to mean

- An interpretative presentation of all exhibits and artifacts which appeals to a wide audience;
- The publication of journals, books, films, video tapes, papers, et al, which represent careful research and presentation of fact;
- The Association will endeavor to collaborate with other educational institutions, including museums, public schools, and institutions of higher learning;
- The planning, design, and presentation of special historic exhibits, and programs for use in community "outreach" programs;
- The exploitation of museum program and resources as a "Living" museum.
